Inaugural Ander Foundation Global Media Studies Professor at Karlstad University, Sweden (2009/10); visiting research fellow at McGill University, Canada (2004); since 2004 Honorary Research Fellow of Hainan University, China. Co-editor of the International Journal of Media and Cultural Politics and twice elected Chair of the Communication Law and Policy Section of the European Communication Research and Education Association. Vice-president for funds of the International Society for Information Studies. She has consulted with the European Parliament, Council of Europe, UK Home Office, UNESCO.

Research areas: regulation of new media technologies, copyright policy, privacy and social media, new forms of media governance, media and democracy, European integration and media/cultural policy, gender and media, global regulation and policy transfer.
